Superstructure Replacement of Bridge No. 108010
Kate Downing Road over Mill Brook**

The Town of Plainfield is seeking bids from qualified firms for the removal of the existing superstructure and the installation of a new pre-engineered, pre-manufactured bridge superstructure on existing abutments for Bridge No. 108010, Kate Downing Road Over Mill Brook.

It is the Town's desire to complete the installation of the bridge prior to December 1, 2016 to allow completion of paving work.

Copies of the Project Specifications (contract documents) may be obtained from the Town of Plainfield Planning and Engineering Department during normal business hours. There is no charge for the Specifications. Sealed bids, clearly marked "Superstructure Replacement of Bridge No. 108010" accompanied by a bid bond issued by an acceptable surety company, equal to 5% of the base bid will be accepted by the Finance Director @ 8 Community Avenue, Plainfield, CT. Monday thru Friday 8:30 A.M. - 4:30 P.M until 11:00 a.m., Thursday, October 27, 2016 at which time the bids will be opened and read at a public meeting.

All bidders must attend a MANDATORY Pre-bid conference on Thursday, October 20, 2016 @ 10:00 a.m. to be eligible to submit a bid. The Pre-bid conference will be held at the Plainfield Town Hall, 8 Community Avenue, Plainfield, Ct.

A Performance Bond will be required of the lowest responsible bidder. Questions may be directed to Mr. Louis Soja, Town Planner at 860-230-3028.

Bidder shall complete and sign the signature page of the General Conditions and the Bid Form in black ink.

The Town reserves the right to reject any and all bids, in whole or in part, to award any item, group of items, or total bids, to waive informality or technical defects, and to reject any non-conforming, non-responsive or conditional bids, if it is deemed to be in the best interest of the Town of Plainfield.
