

## Pool Hours Effective March 1, 2012

### **Welcome to the Plainfield Public Pool**

The pool is located in the basement of the Town Hall at 8 Community Avenue

The swimming pool is open to both Plainfield residents and non-residents during any public swim times. There are specific times designated to adults only. All individuals using the pool are required to follow the posted pool rules and have a membership (purchased at office) or pay a per visit fee (paid to lifeguard at the pool). The daily fees are listed below:

**DAILY POOL FEE: Adults \$3.00 (18+ years) Youth \$2.00 (3- to 17 years)**

**UPON ENTERING POOL PLEASE READ RULES AND REPORT TO THE LIFEGUARD TO SIGN-IN AND PAY FEE.**

**FOR YOUR SAFETY AND HEALTH PLEASE FOLLOW THESE RULES:**

- All patrons shall bathe with warm water and soap before entering the pool.
- Adult swim time is for anyone 18 and older.
- Open swim is for any age. Children must be accompanied by an adult if they cannot touch the bottom of the pool.
- Any patron known or suspected of having a communicable disease, open sores or wounds shall not use the pool.
- Spitting or blowing the nose in pool is prohibited.
- Proper bathing suits must be worn- No cut-offs or T-shirts
- Children in diapers must use a swim diaper and bathing suit.
- No diving is permitted off the deck of the pool.
- Use steps and ladders for getting in and out of the pool.
- Jumping feet first is allowed between ladders in deep end only.
- Long hair must be tied back or in a bathing cap.
- Running, boisterous or rough play in the water, on the deck or in locker room is prohibited
- Only Coast Guard approved flotation is allowed in the pool- An adult must be in the water with each child and children with flotation are restricted to the shallow end.
- No food or glass containers allowed in pool area or locker rooms.
- Do not leave valuables in the locker room. Any lock used must be removed daily.
- **EMERGENCY PHONE in back of pool outside lifeguard closet. In case of an emergency call 911**
