DOG LICENSES

June 1, 2020 – June 30, 2020

JUNE is dog licensing month! All dogs 6 months or older must be licensed. Late fees will apply after August 1st. If the rabies vaccination expired since your last visit, please provide the updated certificate when you renew the license. If you have a neutered or spayed dog being licensed for the first time, you MUST provide proof in the form of a certificate from a licensed veterinarian. <u>YOU MUST</u> **include a stamped, self-addressed envelope for all dog license transactions.**

*Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, dog licenses will <u>NOT</u> be processed in person. You may renew your license in one of the following ways:

2. By Mail -If registering by mail, please include a <u>Dog License Application</u>, up-to-date rabies and/or neuter/spay certificates, and a self-addressed stamped envelope with \$0.69 postage.
