Family Swim: All ages welcome. Children must be able to touch bottom of pool in shallow end to swim alone.

Adult Swim: Must be 18 and older

Adult Lap: Must be 18 and older. Swimmers swim length of the pool and must follow the etiquette for lap swimming

Fees: Adults \$5 and Children \$3.00 per visit.

FLOORS AND DECKS ARE SLIPPERY-Walk with caution.

UPON ENTERING POOL PLEASE READ RULES AND REPORT TO THE LIFEGUARD TO SIGN-IN AND PAY FEE.

-You may purchase a "10" pack good for 10 visits at the Recreation Office for \$50/adult and \$30/child

FOR YOUR SAFETY AND HEALTH PLEASE FOLLOW THESE RULES:

- *All patrons shall bathe with warm water and soap before entering the pool.
- *Any patron known or suspected of having a communicable disease, open sores or wounds shall not use the pool.
- *Spitting or blowing the nose in pool is prohibited.
- *Proper bathing suits must be worn- No cut-offs or T-shirts
- *Children in diapers must use a swim diaper and bathing suit.
- *No diving is permitted off the deck of the pool.
- *Use steps and ladders for getting in and out of the pool.
- *Jumping feet first is allowed between ladders in deep end only.
- *Long hair must be tied back or in a bathing cap.
- *Running, boisterous or rough play in the water, on the deck or in locker room is prohibited
- *Only Coast Guard approved flotation is allowed in the pool- An adult must be in the water with each child and children with flotation are restricted to the shallow end.
- *No food or glass containers allowed in pool area or locker rooms.
- *Do not leave valuables in the locker room. Any lock used must be removed daily.
